"GATE stands for Gifted and Talented Education. GATE students at Paragon are identified with a Cognitive Abilities test. Students who score 97% or higher on any of the three categories: Verbal, Nonverbal and Quantitative are identified as Gifted. Once identified families will work with the gifted education coordinator to design a PLP (personalized Learning Plan) this ensure the academic needs of the gifted learner are met at Paragon. The Gifted Ed Coordinator will then work with teachers to implement the PLP. This gifted parallel curriculum could look many different ways. Self-Contained classrooms, Curriculum Compacting, Credit by Examination are examples of PLP's currently in place at Paragon."
